

Club membership fees, collected

One side of A4 on what this does, where the money goes, and what stays your club's decision.

WHAT IT IS

Clayside collects your club's membership subs by Direct Debit and keeps a register of who has paid. It is being built onto the software that already runs your box leagues and your club ladder, so it holds one list of members rather than a second one.

THE JOB IT REMOVES

Nobody reconciles anything. There are no bank references to match to names, no statement to read down, and no working out whether a payment came from a member or from their parent. Each payment knows whose it is because it was set up as theirs.

Renewals then happen without anyone typing. The instruction survives the year, so you set next season's prices, check the list and collect. Members who are staying do nothing at all, which is the group you most want to keep.

YOU SET THE TERMS, NOT US

Your own categories and prices: adult, student, junior, over-65, off-peak, social, life member, whatever your club publishes. Under-5s at nothing. Family rates priced by how many people they cover, so one family pays once and every person in it shows as paid.

Your membership year runs when it runs, and somebody joining halfway through pays a part year on your rule rather than ours.

WHERE THE MONEY GOES

Into your club's bank, through your club's own payment account, with your club's name on your members' statements. We never hold your money and we never see a member's bank details: those are typed on the payment provider's own page. Stop using Clayside and the arrangement between your club and its members is untouched.

WHAT STAYS YOUR DECISION

Refunds, waived fees and hardship rates are yours, each recorded with a reason beside it. Reminders are off until you turn them on. Collection is a button somebody at your club presses, and it names who will be charged and the total before it does anything.

IF A MEMBER WILL NOT USE DIRECT DEBIT

Your bank details can sit on the payment screen beside it. They send a transfer, and you tick them off when it lands. Cash and cheques work the same way. Direct Debit is what we build around because it removes the work rather than moving it, but it is not the only thing the register holds.

THE PART ONLY CLAYSIDE CAN DO

A payment system holds payers and a league holds players, and at most clubs those two lists have never met. Here they are the same people, so paid status sits beside the name on your box rosters and your club ladder. When you plan a season we can offer to leave unpaid members out, off by default and always will be: whether somebody plays is a committee's call, and nobody is removed from a box already running.

WHERE THIS IS, AND WHAT TO DO

Designed in full and not yet built. We are building it with a club that asked for it, because what a real club needs beats what looked good on a plan. It is not priced yet. The box leagues and the club ladder are live today.

Tell us how your club runs subs now: your categories, your year, and what goes wrong every spring. That is what decides what gets built and in what order.
